

GIFT AID

If you pay UK income tax and/or capital gains tax you can substantially increase the value of your donations (including your subscription) to BACSA, at no cost to yourself, by completing a Gift Aid declaration.

BACSA will reclaim tax (currently 25p) on every £1 you subscribe or donate to BACSA.

For such payments to attract Gift Aid you must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax, for each tax year (6 April to 5 April), at least equal to the amount of tax that all charities to which you donate will reclaim for that tax year. Other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify.

If you pay income tax at above the basic rate (currently 20%) you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.

Please notify BACSA if you want to cancel this Declaration, if you change your name or home address, or if you no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains to cover the amounts that you might give.

GIFT AID DECLARATION

Please treat all subscriptions and donations paid by me to the British Association for Cemeteries in South Asia from the date of this declaration as Gift Aid donations, until I notify BACSA to the contrary.
